She said, "Yes, for so much." **9** Then Peter said to her, "How is it that you have agreed together to test the Spirit of the Lord? Look, the feet of those who have buried your husband are at the door, and they will carry you out." **10** Then immediately she fell down at his feet and breathed her last.

Cheating Servant

- Then James and John, the sons of Zebedee, came to Him, saying, "Teacher, we want You to do for us whatever we ask." **36** And He said to them, "What do you want Me to do for you?" **37** They said to Him, "Grant us that we may sit, one on Your right hand and the other on Your left, in Your glory." (Mark 10:35-37)
